Whereas, *Community Health Workers' endeavors to improve health care quality for members of these communities ensures that the City of Cincinnati remains a center for health care innovation; and,*


Whereas, *Community Health Workers' efforts to conduct outreach and health education, provide support for clients and patients, and advocate for reducing disparities in health care should be commended.*
